The Bawdsey Radar WW2 Transmitter Block here on the Suffolk coast was built in 1937 and has recently undergone a massive restoration programme. In this short video we will take you through a typical visit so you can see how we have new measures in place to keep your visit Covid safe while you explore and discover the secrets of radar.

ARRIVAL	Commentary
Pre-booked and pre-paid visits	<b>Before you come to the Transmitter Block you will need to book your visit which takes a few minutes by phone or Take a look at our website for the details of how to book.</b>
Track and test data	<b>We will ask you for some brief contact details as required by the current Test and Trace regulations</b>
Face coverings to be worn inside the museum (if they can be) and BRT vols will be wearing PPE too	<b>Unless an exemption applies, we ask that you to wear face coverings to come in to the museum – we have face masks available at reception if you need one. Our volunteers will be wearing them too</b>
Please don't come if you or anyone in your party feels poorly	<b>If you or anyone in your party is not feeling well please don't come. We will of course refund the admission price.</b>
IN THE MUSEUM	
Hand sanitiser available throughout the museum – please use at entrance and at exit	<b>Hand sanitisers are available throughout the museum – please use it, especially at reception when you arrive and when you leave the building.</b>

There is a designated one-way route through the museum	<b>A one-way system is in operation and you will be guided by signs and floor markings.</b>
Please keep 2 metres apart	<b>Please respect social distancing measures of 2 metres while in the museum</b>
A small number of interactives won't be available but there's lots more to explore.....	<b>We have had to make a few changes to keep everyone safe but don't worry, there is still lots to explore during your visit</b>  <b>Our friendly volunteers are still there to help you and answer questions.</b>
Extra cleaning in place	<b>And surfaces are being cleaned regularly ....</b>
Public loo with hand washing facilities on site	<b>....including our on-site toilets</b>
<b>MISCELLANEOUS</b>	
The shop will be open but sorry, no browsing, but is a range of lovely gifts for sale	<b>The award-winning shop is open with a range of great gifts on display. No browsing at the moment...every item purchased comes straight out of the stock cupboard for you.</b>
No cash payments, contactless only on site	<b>We are only taking card payments, so please no cash!</b>
